





Mistakes come when people:


- 1) They do not know the concepts of scripture. It is not enough to be able to rattle off verses, you need to know the meaning of the scripture.


5. "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away. " (Matthew 24:35, Mark 13:31, Luke 21:33 KJV)

- a) The Bible is NOT Subject to Man's Determination as to what is scripture and what is not.
- b) The Bible is a Guidebook . . . It changes us, we don't change it!



## Quantum Rules (Continued)

7) *As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all them that trust in him. (Psalm 18:30, II Samuel 22:31)*

- a) The Word of the LORD is not theories, it is law designed to guide us in our way.
- b) Every word of God *is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him. (Proverbs 30:5)*

- a) The actual word or a form of the word in the text.
  - b) A synonym (or sometimes an antonym) of the word in the text.
  - c) A discussion of the word or its concept in the text.







## Genesis 31 – Differential Analysis

- There are 16 Occurrences of the word “God” in Chapter 31.
- There are 2,697 occurrences of the word “God” in the Old Testament.
- There are 929 chapters in the Old Testament.
- The “Expected Value” or the number of times the word “God” should appear in each chapter of the Old Testament is 2.90 times.
- The Word “God” appears in this chapter 5.5 times more than it should.

# The Infinity Code

- 1) All Hebrew letters have a numeric value.
- 2) Therefore, if all Hebrew letters have numerical values, all Hebrew words must have numeric values as well.
- 3) Accordingly, if you take the value of the Hebrew word and go to that chapter in the bible, you will find one or more of the following:
  - a) The actual word or form of the word in the text.
  - b) A synonym (or sometimes an antonym of the word in the text.
  - c) A discussion of the word or its concept in the text.
