Ge 14:5 And in the fourteenth year came Chedorlaomer, and the kings that *were* with him, and smote the <u>Rephaims</u> in Ashteroth Karnaim, and the Zuzims in Ham, and the Emims in Shaveh Kiriathaim,

Ge 15:20 And the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Rephaims,

De 2:11 Which also were accounted giants, as the Anakims; but the Moabites call them Emims.

De 2:20 (That also was accounted a land of giants: giants dwelt therein in old time; and the Ammonites call them Zamzummims;
